



## -ICS Pig Roast- Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

### **What is the ICS Pig Roast?**

- It's a community building/pig roasting event hosted by the Dads Club, wherein teams from the school's different grade levels, friends and alumni compete to see which team has the best pig. There are two competitions ***People's Choice and Judge's Choice***. This event features food tasting, live entertainment, age dedicated activities, vendor bazaar, etc.

### **When does the ICS Pig Roast take place?**

- The event will take place on Saturday, **November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2023**.

### **Where does the ICS Pig Roast take place?**

- On school grounds (Carport, Big Shelter, Baseball Field Area).

### **Who may attend the ICS Pig Roast event?**

- Student, student's family, and friends who purchase a ticket.

### **When and how may I purchase tickets for the ICS Pig Roast?**

### **What do I get for the purchase of my ticket to the ICS Pig Roast?**

- Admission to the event, tasting of pigs and sides until supplies last.

### **Who needs to buy a ticket for the ICS Pig Roast?**

- Anyone over the age of 3

### **Who may complete the ICS Pig Roast event?**

- Teams are created based on school grade classes. For example, if there are two classes in a grade level, there could be at least two teams. Friends and alumni can also create teams and compete.

**What are the costs to complete the ICS Pig Roast event?**

- Each team is responsible for purchasing their pig (the Pig Roast Committee will secure favorable pricing with a local slaughterhouses), utensils, booth decorations (limited to inside the carport), and sides being served. The school may refund a team up to a total of \$250.00, only if the team has secured sponsorship exceeding \$250.00. The school may refund up to \$250.00 per team for items related to purchasing pig, utensils, and condiments, but no beverages (non-alcoholic or alcoholic).

**I don't know how to roast a pig, but I want to participate who do I speak with?**

- Contact the school office. The school is allowing up to a total of 4 hours for volunteering during this event. Complete the volunteer form that was sent via email.

**I have multiple children attending the school, what do I do?**

- Unfortunately, you may only assist one team during the event.

**Will beverages be sold during the event?**

- Yes, water, soda, beer, and wine will be sold during the event. You must provide a legal government ID to purchase and consume alcohol.

**May I bring outside food or drinks to the ICS Pig Roast?**

- No. Small child snacks will be allowed.

**May we bring chairs, blankets, and tents to the ICS Pig Roast?**

- Yes. No skateboards, roller-skates, rollerblades, bicycles, or other items with wheels or engines.
