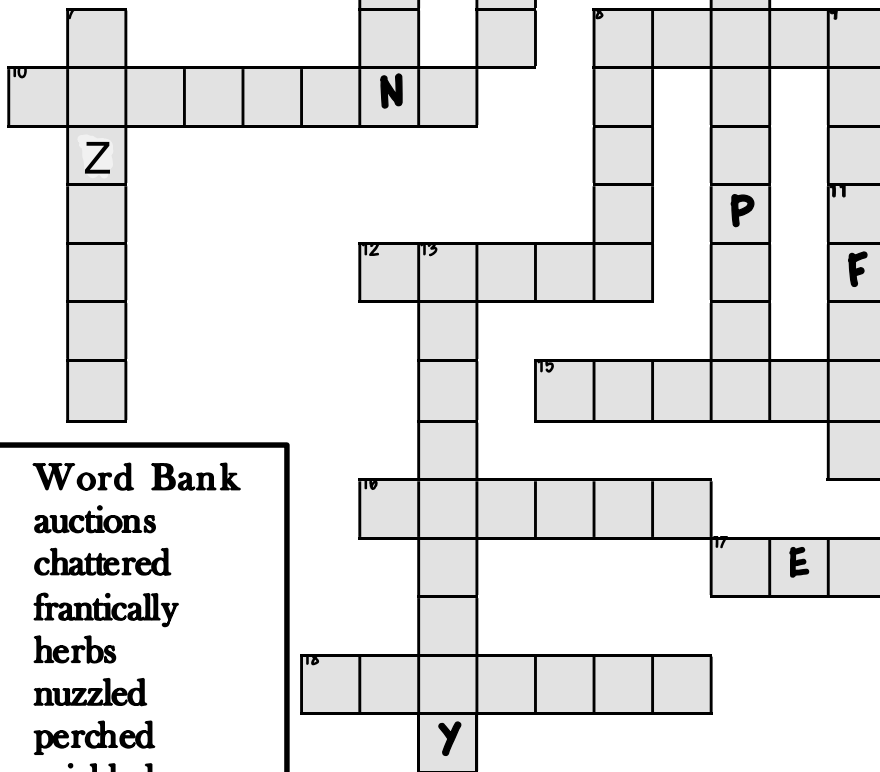
Please choose **one** activity from the Choice Board.
