<p>Make an eye-catching ad that would make others want to read the book.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Create a catchy title or slogan• Write a short summary (4–6 sentences) without giving away the ending• Add drawings or symbols that match the story• Mention the main character and a big challenge they face	<p>Pretend you are interviewing a main character (like Homer Smith or Mother Maria).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write 6 interesting questions that explore what the character thinks and feels• Answer each question the way the character would• Use correct punctuation (especially for questions and answers)• Show how the character changes or grows	<p>Make a collage that shows the big ideas (themes) in the story.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use drawings, magazine cutouts, or printed images• Focus on themes like faith, hard work, community, or helping others• Write a reflection paragraph (6–8 sentences)• Explain what your collage shows and how the themes appear in the story
