Creative Book Advertisement

Character Interview

Pretend you are interviewing a main character (like Homer Smith or Mother Maria).

- Write 6 interesting questions that explore what the character thinks and feels
- Answer each question the way the character would
- Use correct punctuation (especially for questions and answers)
- Show how the character changes or grows

Theme Collage & Reflection

Make a collage that shows the big ideas (themes) in the story.

- Use drawings, magazine cutouts, or printed images
- Focus on themes like faith, hard work, community, or helping others
- Write a reflection paragraph (6–8 sentences)
