<p>Make an ad that encourages others to read the book.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Come up with a fun title or slogan• Write a short summary (4–6 sentences) that tells what the book is about (no spoilers!)• Add drawings or pictures that match the story• Include the main character and problem	<p>Pretend you are interviewing a character from the book (like Janie or Reeve).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write 6 questions that ask about their thoughts and feelings• Answer the questions the way the character would• Use the right punctuation (especially for questions and answers)• Show how the character changed in the story	<p>Make a collage to show the themes (main ideas) in the book.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use drawings, magazine pictures, or words to show big ideas like identity, family, or truth• Be neat and creative• Write a paragraph (6–8 sentences) explaining your collage• Tell what the theme means and how it connects to the book
